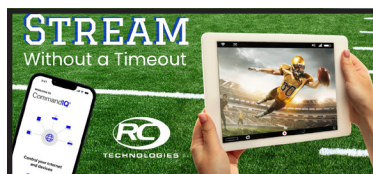

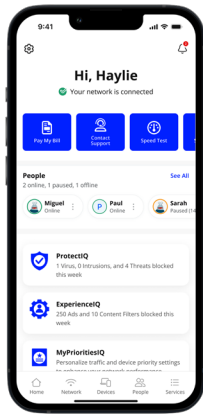

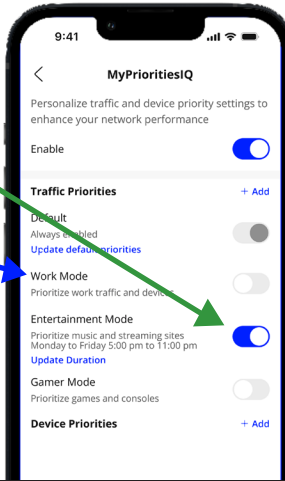

Important Notice

Customer Proprietary Network Information

Federal law allows us to use information from your current records to market and advise you for new products and services that may satisfy your communication needs, unless you notify us otherwise.

What is this "information"?

This information is called "Customer Proprietary Network Information" or "CPNI" - relating to your telecommunications services you receive from RC Technologies. CPNI includes things such as the type and quantity of the services you subscribe to, the equipment and facilities you used to receive those services, as well as the telephone numbers, dates, times and the duration of calls you place.

How can we use this information?

From time to time, RC Technologies may change our services offerings and make available new features or services that may enhance or improve the services to which you are already subscribed. Allowing us to use the CPNI in your account gives us the ability to give you more personalized service and offer you the products and services that best fit your needs. We DO NOT sell or in any way provide your account information to any other company. We do however, provide 911 location records, which we are required to by law provide, if you are a telephone customer.

Who will be able to use this information?

ONLY RC Technologies. *Will RC protect information?* YES! You have the right and we have the duty, under federal law, to protect the confidentiality of this information. Therefore, regardless of whether you consent or not, to allow us to continue providing you education mailings, your account will be treated confidentially.

What do I need to do?

No action on your part is necessary unless you want to restrict RC Technologies' use of your CPNI for the purpose of tailoring our services offerings to your individual needs. Should you wish to restrict use of your CPNI, please call us at (605) 637-5211 or send an email to csrs@rctechteam.com with your request within 30 days of receipt of this notice. Your decision on the use of CPNI will remain valid until you revoke or limit the approval or denial. This can be done any time by calling our business office at (605) 637-5211. Your denial of approval for RC Technologies to use your CPNI will not affect the quality of your service, have an effect on the products and services to which you currently subscribe. However, you may miss an opportunity to learn new innovative products that could enhance your service.
